## Scope of Work:

This project includes the rehabilitation of the historic steel Pratt truss pedestrian bridge and approach spans to East Swinney Park to the west and Mechanic St. to the east. The project scope includes rehabilitation and/or replacement of multiple lower chord pins, multiple low chord eyebars, partial replacement of floor stringers, decorative portal replacement, rivet installation, new decking, mudwall extensions, railing reconstruction, cleaning and painting of the entire structure and approach span, tree removal and mitigation plantings.

Three bids were received through a public bid process via QuestCDN on behalf of the Board of Park Commissioners on March 5, 2024, and Hamilton Hunter Builders was the lowest, qualified bidder.

## Board Approval:

At this time, I would like to request approval for a contract with <a href="Hamilton Hunter Builders"><u>Hamilton Hunter Builders</u></a> at a total cost of <a href="\$\frac{\$1,277,309.76">, with the funding to come out of the Parks Cumulative Capital Funds.
