Project Description:

Through the City's 2024 Supplemental Economic Development Distribution, \$1,200,000 has been allocated to Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation for playground improvements in six parks. The following is a summary of known project costs for playground equipment and anticipated costs for safety surfacing and playground borders.
