Financial Objective and Justification Statement

The financial objective of Salomon Farm Park is to be self-sustaining with 100% recovery of operating costs through programs and rental fees. Salomon Farm Park's revenue sources include facility and outdoor space rentals, programs, including Farmin' Fun Day Camp, flower sales, and events. Old Barn rentals are in high demand and are often booked every weekend during the season.

During the 2024 season, there were several fees and updates to the fees that were approved through the Deputy Director of Recreation. We are making the Board aware of those fee changes and updates. The first fee to bring to the Board of Park Commissioner's attention was a typo within the Catering Rates in the 11/9/2023 Fee Recommendation. In the 6-hour rental section for the Old Barn (Monday – Thursday) the catering rate should have read \$75 instead the typo reflected \$0. The Deputy Director approved the rate to return to \$75.

Next, changes were made to the age requirement for free riders on the wagon ride and the addition of Dahlia flower sales. The age for free riders was adjusted from 5 years old to 2 years old, aligning with other areas in the parks department. Younger children, like 2-year-olds, are more likely to sit comfortably on a lap, whereas 5-year-olds typically prefer their seat. Additionally, introducing dahlias to the flower field has allowed the farm to expand its offerings beyond sunflowers. Due to their popularity, the Deputy Director approved pricing dahlias per stem at the same rate as sunflowers before the start of the u-pick season.

We request the removal of the combined 6-hour rental option for the Old Barn and Homestead from Monday through Thursday. We are not offering special rates for facility combinations, so potential renters can simply rent both facilities separately if desired, making a separate combination option unnecessary.

Lastly, we propose removing the six-hour rental option for the Homestead on Fridays through Sundays. The Homestead would only be available as an add-on to the Old Barn rental, rather than as a standalone option. Currently, most Old Barn rentals include the Homestead, which is intended as a space for the bridal party to prepare before the ceremony.

Projected Results / Outcomes

With the proposed updates, we anticipate additional revenue at Salomon Farm Park of \$550

Merchandise Pricing

Merchandise are items or goods purchased to be resold on their own or to create items for resale. The farm will follow industry standards in retail operations. For most merchandise, the farm will use a multiplier between the range of 1.25 to 3.00, or round up to the nearest dollar. Pricing will include any applicable sales tax, labor or other costs.

Produce Pricing

Prices of products, florals, crops, and other good produced or grown at Salomon Farm Park sold by staff and volunteers at Salomon Farm Park.

Farmers' Market Pricing

Pricing varies for each type of produce. Produce prices are evaluated each year at supermarkets and farmers' markets to determine pricing. Produce prices vary between 25 cents to 10 dollar per item.

Merchandise, produce, farmers' market pricing will be set in writing by the Manager of Salomon Farm Park, Outdoor Recreation and Boating. No item price shall exceed \$25 without written approval from the Deputy Director or Director.

Price changes and other pricing may be approved in writing by Deputy Director or Director.
