# Financial Objective and Justification Statement

The financial objective of Salomon Farm Park is to be fully self-sustaining, with 100% of operating costs recovered through programs and rental fees. Our revenue sources include facility and outdoor space rentals, programs such as Farmin' Fun Day Camp, flower sales, and special events. Old Barn rentals remain in particularly high demand and are often booked nearly every weekend during the season. As our rental program has expanded over the last several years. operating and staffing costs have increased as well. To remain competitive in the industry and to ensure these costs are covered, we are proposing updates to our rental pricing structure. At this stage, two rental coordinators are required to manage operations—one serving as lead administrator and the other providing direct support during rentals.

We are proposing a \$25 increase for the Wolf Family Learning Center. This adjustment will help offset staffing expenses while keeping the rates lower than many comparable facilities. In addition, we would like to establish a full-day rental option at \$750, which includes a \$50 incentive for those who choose to reserve the facility for the entire day. The Old Barn weekday rental would increase from \$375 to \$400, and weekend non-peak and peak rentals would each increase by \$25. Combination pricing that includes the Old Barn and Homestead would be adjusted accordingly, while rentals that include all three facilities—the Old Barn, Homestead, and Learning Center—would to include a \$50 discount incentive for booking the full property.

We also propose redefining the rental calendar to better reflect actual demand. Weekend nonpeak months would be April, July, and November, as these have historically been the slowest periods. Weekend peak months would be adjusted to include May, June, and August through October, recognizing the growing popularity of those months in recent years. Security costs for rentals will also increase beginning in 2026, and this change is reflected in the updated pricing structure. We also recommend increasing the rental rates for the rustic chairs and rustic wood tables. Our current pricing is lower than that of competitors, and an adjustment would help better cover the costs associated with staff setup and storage.

We are also seeking approval to update the Fall Harvest Festival admission per car to a more general title of Special Event admission per car. In addition, we would like to add a new option for Special Event Admission per person.

Finally, we recommend increasing both farmers market and single-day vendor fees. Even with this increase, our pricing remains lower than several comparable events and will help us remain competitive while continuing to support operational needs.

## **Merchandise Pricing**

Merchandise is items or goods purchased to be resold on their own or to create items for resale. The farm will follow industry standards in retail operations. For most merchandise, the farm will use a multiplier between the range of 1.25 to 3.00, or round up to the nearest dollar. Pricing will include any applicable sales tax, labor, or other costs.

## **Produce Pricing**

Prices of products, florals, crops, and other goods produced or grown at Salomon Farm Park are sold by staff and volunteers at Salomon Farm Park.

## Farmers' Market Pricing

Pricing varies for each type of produce. Produce prices are evaluated each year at supermarkets and farmers' markets to determine pricing. Produce prices vary between 25 cents to 10 per item.

Merchandise, produce, and farmers' market pricing will be set in writing by the Manager of Salomon Farm Park, Outdoor Recreation, and Boating. No item price shall exceed \$25 without written approval from the Deputy Director or Director.

Price changes and other pricing may be approved in writing by the Deputy Director or the Director.
