## FINANCIAL OBJECTIVE AND JUSTIFICATION STATEMENT:

Promenade Park is a long-term, transformative, economic, and community development project to create a world-class riverfront in downtown Fort Wayne. In addition, it serves as a catalyst for private development in downtown Fort Wayne. There are several goals of Promenade Park, which include creating civic spaces and experiences for the public to enjoy; encouraging social interactions, special occasions, and everyday outings; provide indoor and outdoor meeting spaces to accommodate small and intimate to large and spacious events; and providing a world-class urban park.

The park will be operated in such a way as to allow open access throughout the park at all times. Rental spaces will be focused on 4 primary areas (Wells Street Bridge, Park Foundation Pavilion, Auer Lawn, and Old National Bank Plaza). Although requests for other spaces may be negotiated to serve the needs of the rental and maintain available public access.

There is much interest from the public in a variety of rentals in Promenade Park. Due to the unique nature of the park, rentals require more staff attention to work with renters to ensure that their event is a success, and general access to the park remains open

## FEE RECOMMENDATION


See attached Proposed Fee Schedule. 15% of each rental will be put into fund 428-P295 for future facility improvements, and the remaining balance will be put in 121-P295. Security fees will be run separately through a non-reverting account. Other fees will operate out of their dedicated funds (422-DRAG and 422-RVMR).

## PROJECTED RESULTS OUTCOME:

We anticipate these fees will bring an additional \$8,500 in fees in 2026.
