Truck 08, 2004 Ford F150 pickup truck. Acquisition cost: \$15,192. Current odometer reading is 62,035 miles.



Truck 08. This vehicle was assigned to Salomon farm to move equipment and supplies. They now have a newer Ford F250 and no longer need this vehicle. It's age and body condition along with the fact that this is a surplus vehicle make this an ideal truck to send to auction.

Truck 61, 2007 Ford F150 pickup truck. Acquisition cost: \$16,760. Current odometer reading is 187,715 miles.



Truck 61. Originally assigned to the night utility crew and later moved to the Jennings Community center. This truck was most recently utilized by the youth centers for the Park C employee to transport materials between them. A newer truck was recently assigned to that role leaving this as an excess vehicle. Its high mileage and condition warrant that it be sent to auction.

Truck 40, 1995 Chevrolet 3500 flatbed truck. Acquisition cost: \$24,400. Current odometer reading is 65,842 miles.



Truck 40. Previously assigned to the maintenance techs. The maintenance techs used this truck to transport large building materials. Recently, a new flatbed truck was purchased for this role making this a surplus vehicle. The age and condition of this truck make it an ideal candidate to be sent to auction.

Truck 153, 2011 Ford F150 pickup truck. Acquisition cost: \$17,296. Current odometer reading is 155,614 miles.



Truck 153. Assigned to Forestry. This truck was previously the forestry supervisor's truck and was then used by tree division employees to inspect storm damage. The high mileage and body condition make it a candidate for replacement. This truck will be replaced in forestry by a 2013 Ford F250 that is currently underutilized. 153 will be sent to auction.
